### **Location of the camp:**

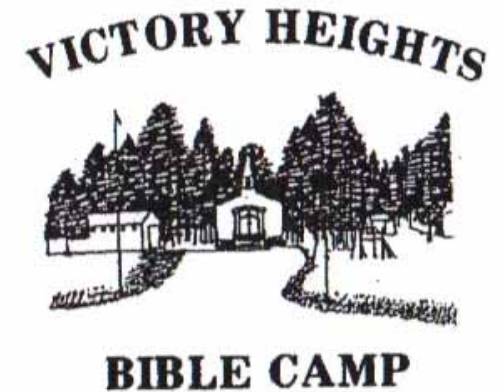
**From Chadron:** Approximately 15 miles south of Chadron on Hwy.385, then 5 miles west.

**Grades:** completed 3, 4, 5,6  
**Dates:** Monday, June 6th  
Thru Saturday, June 11th  
**Starts:** Monday, June 6th

## THINGS TO BRING:

- Bible, pen, pencil, notebook
- Sleeping bag & pillow (bedding)
- Towel, washcloth, soap, etc.
- Toothbrush, toothpaste
- Flashlight
- Clothing:
  - Bring only casual clothes.
  - No halter tops, or spaghetti straps
  - Shorts no shorter than the tip of index finger at your side
  - One piece swimsuit
  - **Be prepared to get dirty!!!**

- Bring two pair of shoes, at least 1 pair for hiking and 1 pair for running.

## THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Medication must be turned in to the camp nurse upon registration.
- The camp director reserves the right to ask campers to change their attire if it is inappropriate.
- All campers money will be kept in our camp bank for convenience and safety.
- Any remaining funds will be returned the last day of camp.
